Grandchildren will serve as pallbearers. Honorary pallbearers will be Charlie Brownlow and Billy Matson.

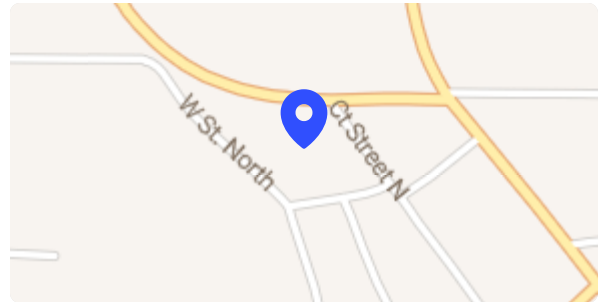

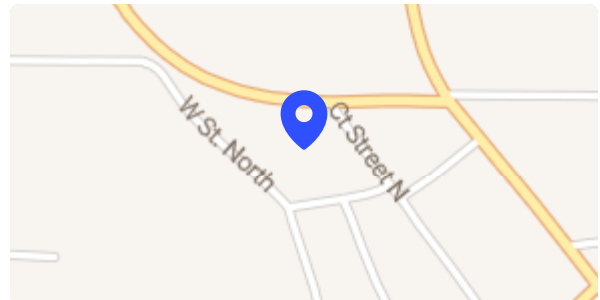
